**Joseph S. Nye** is Distinguished Service Professor at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government and author of The Powers to Lead. He is a former US Assistant Secretary of Defence, and Professor of Government at Harvard.



**Joseph Stiglitz** is a Nobel Laureate and Professor of Economics at Columbia University. He chaired the Council of Economic Advisers to President Clinton and was Chief Economist and Senior Vice President at the World Bank.



**Michael Spence** is the 2001 Nobel Laureate in Economics, and the Professor Emeritus at Stanford University. Further, he currently chairs the Commission on Growth and Development.



**Francis Fukuyama** is the famed and controversial author of The End of History and the Last Man, and teaches at the School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University.



**Mikhail Gorbachev** the former president of the Soviet Union was awarded the Nobel Peace prize in 1990 for helping to bring the Cold War to an end. He is now president of Green Cross International.



**Henry Kissinger** is a former US Secretary of State and was a frequent outside adviser to President George W Bush. In 1982 he formed Kissinger Associates, an international consulting firm, which he now runs.



**Nouriel Roubini** is Professor of Economics at New York University and Chairman of Roubini Global Economics, a popular economics website. He was a senior advisor on the President's Council of Economic Advisors.



**Dani Rodrik**, Professor of Political Economy at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government, is the first recipient of the Social Science Research Council's Albert O. Hirschman Prize.
